MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

1. The name of the Society shall be "The Haryana Institute of Rural Development."
2. The registered office of the Society shall be at Nilokheri in the State of Haryana.
3. The objects for which the Society is formed are to organise training courses in Rural Development specifically as following :-

- (a) Course for new entrants in the services of various departments attending to the Rural Development activities, District Development and Panchayat Officers, Block Development and Panchayat Officers, and training in research.
- (b) Special courses, Seminars/Workshops for Officers working in various Departments of the State Government attending to the rural Development activities.
- (e) Mid-career refresher courses for Officers who have done 10-15 years service.

In addition to this, the Society may also undertake the following activities :-

- (i) Participate in the organisation of training research and study courses, conferences, Seminars/workshops and lectures.
 - (ii) Undertake, promote and co-ordinate research analytical studies and training in the fields of Rural Development and management, on its own or in collaboration with other Rural Development agencies including Universities, Rural Development Training Institutions of the Govt. of India and other Governments.
 - (iii) Undertake and provide for publication of Journals, research papers, books and take up any other allied activities which will further the cause of training in and promotion of the study of Rural Development and management.
4. Pursuant to the aforesaid objects, the Society may :
 - (a) receive grants of money, gifts, donations and subscriptions of cash and securities and of any property either movable or immovable;
 - (b) invest and deal with funds and money of the Society;
 - (c) impose and recover fees and charges for the services rendered by it;
 - (d) purchase, hire, take on lease, exchange, or otherwise acquire property movable or immovable which may be necessary or convenient for the purpose of the Society and construct, alter and/or maintain such buildings and works as may be necessary for carrying out the objects of the Society;

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- (e) sell, mortgage, lease, exchange or otherwise transfer or dispose of all or any property, movable or immovable of the Society, for the furtherance of the objects of the Society subject to the prior approval of the Government of Haryana;
- (f) borrow and raise money on mortgage, promissory notes or other securities founded or based upon all or any of the properties and assets of the Society or without any securities;
- (g) create Reserve Fund, Sinking Fund, Insurance Fund or any other Special Fund whether for depreciation, repair, improvement, extension or maintenance of any of the properties or rights of the Society;
- (h) create administrative, technical, ministerial and other posts in the Society and make appointments thereto in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Society;
- (i) to offer prizes and to grant scholarships and stipends in furtherance of the objects of the Society;
- (j) establish a Provident Fund for the benefit of the staff of the Society on any section thereto;
- (k) make rules and bye-laws for the conduct of the affairs of the Society and add to, amend, vary or rescind them from time to time; and
- (l) do all such other lawful things as are conducive or incidental to the attainment of the above objects.

5. The Executive Committee of the Society shall be the body constituted as such under the rules of the Society. The names, occupations and addresses of the first members of the Executive Committee to whom, as per rules of the Society, the management of its affairs has been entrusted are as follows :-

6. The appointment of the Chairman and Members is by virtue of their office.
7. All property of the Society, movable or immovable, shall vest in the Executive Committee.
8. The income and property of the Society, howsoever derived, shall be applied towards the promotion of the objects as set forth in the Memorandum of Association. In respect of expenditure of grants made by the Government of Haryana, it shall be subject to such directions as the Government of Haryana may give from time to time. No portion of the income and property of the Society shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus, or otherwise howsoever by way of profits to persons who may at any time be or have been member of the Society or to any person claiming through them provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment, in good faith, of remuneration to any member or any other person in return for services rendered to the Society or for travelling allowance, halting allowance and other similar charges.

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9. A copy of the Rules and Regulations of the Society certified to be correct by three members of the Executive Committee is filed with the Registrar of Societies Haryana, Chandigarh alongwith the Memorandum of Association.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

Short Title

- I. These rules may be called "The Rules of the Haryana Institute of Rural Development."

Definitions

- II. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires :-

- (a) "The institute" means the Haryana Institute of Rural Development.
- (b) "The Government" means the Government of Haryana.
- (c) "The Governing Body" means the Governing Body of the Institute.
- (d) "The Executive Committee" means the Executive Committee of the Institute.
- (e) "President" means the President of the Institute.
- (f) "Vice President" means the Vice President of the Institute.
- (g) "Chairman" means Chairman of the Executive Committee.
- (h) "Director" means Director of the Institute.
- (i) "Prescribed" means prescribed by Rules and Bye-laws made by the Institute.
- (j) "Academic Staff" means the employees of the Institute engaged in education, Training, research or consultancy.
- (k) "The Rules" means any other Rules and Bye-Laws of the Institute.

Composition of the Institute

- III. The Institute shall consist of the following members (subject to their consent):-

The appointment of President and Vice President and members is by virtue of their office.

IV. Roll of Members

The Institute shall keep a roll of members giving their occupation and addresses and every member shall sign the same. If a member of the Institute changes his address, he shall notify his new address to the Director of the Institute, who shall thereupon cause his new address to be entered in the roll of members. If the member fails to notify his new address, the address given in the roll of members shall be deemed to be his address.

V. Term of Office

1. The term of office of members shall be two years. They shall, however, be eligible for reappointment.
2. A member of the Institute may resign his membership by a letter addressed to the Director, but his resignation shall take effect only on its acceptance by the President.
3. A member of the Institute shall cease to be a member if he becomes insolvent or of unsound mind or is convicted of a criminal offence involving moral turpitude.

VI. Officers of the Institute

The following shall be the officers of the Institute, namely :-

1. President ;
2. Vice-President ;
3. Chairman of the Executive Committee;
4. Director-cum-Member Secretary of the Institute, and

5. Such other officers as the Executive Committee may, from time to time, appoint.

The Director of the Institute shall be appointed by the Executive Committee in consultation with the Government of Haryana for a period of three years at a time on such terms and conditions of service as the Government may prescribe. The Director of the Institute is eligible for re-appointment.

VII. The Governing Body

- (i) There shall be a Governing Body of the Institute and it shall be composed of all the members of the Institute.
- (ii) The Annual General Meeting of the Governing Body shall be held on such dates and at such time and place as may be determined by the President.
- (iii) The Governing Body shall meet at least once a year.
- (iv) For the purpose of the last sub-rule, each year shall be deemed to commence on the first day of April and terminate on the thirty first day of March of the following calendar year.
- (v) The President may convene a special meeting of the Governing Body whenever he thinks fit. A special meeting may also be convened on the written requisition of not less than one-third of the members of the Institute.
- (vi) Every notice calling a meeting of the Governing Body shall state the date, time and place at which such meeting will be held and shall ordinarily be served upon every member of Governing Body not less than fifteen clear days before the day appointed for the meeting.
- (vii) The accidental omission to give notice to, or the non-receipt of notice by any member or other person to whom it should be given, shall not invalidate the proceedings of the meeting.
- (viii) The President shall preside over the meeting of the Governing Body and in the absence of the President, the Vice-President of the Institute shall preside.
- (ix) Nine members of the Governing Body present in person shall form a quorum. No quorum shall be required for an adjourned meeting.
- (x) All disputed questions of meetings of the Governing Body shall be determined by vote.
- (xi) Each member of the Institute shall have one vote.

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- (xii) In case of an equality of votes, the person presiding over the meeting shall have the casting vote.
- (xiii) The President may invite any person other than a member to attend the meeting of Governing Body. Such invitee shall not, however, be entitled to vote at the meeting.
- (xiv) The Governing Body shall function notwithstanding any vacancy therein and notwithstanding any defect in the appointment or nomination of any member and no act or proceeding of the Governing Body shall be invalidated or nullified merely by reason of the existence of any vacancy therein or any defect in the appointment or nomination of any member.

VIII. Functions and Powers of the Governing Body

The Governing Body shall have the following powers and functions, namely, to:-

- (a) approve the Annual Budget of the Institute;
- (b) receive and approve the Annual Accounts of the Institute;
- (c) approve the basic thrust of Research Programme of the Institute;
- (d) approve Policy Guidelines regarding the nature of courses to be run by the Institute;
- (e) seek affiliation with a University/Research Organisation and to offer degrees/certificates.
- (f) consider the balance sheet audited accounts for the outgoing year.
- (g) add to and amend the rules of the Institute.
- (h) frame Bye-Laws, not inconsistent with the rules for the regulation of the business of the Institute with particular reference to preparation, approval of the budget estimates, the sanctioning of the expenditure, reappropriation of funds, making and execution of contract, investment of funds of the Institute, procedure and terms and conditions governing scholarships, fellowships and deputations, grants-in-aid, training and research schemes and projects, rules of conduct and other conditions of services of the staff of the Institute.
- (i) constitute adhoc/special committees, with or without power to coopt, for disposal of any business of the Institute or for advice in any matter pertaining to the Institute, and

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- (j) perform such other functions as are entrusted to it under these rules.
- (k) any other item which is necessary.

IX. The Executive Committee

There shall be an Executive Committee of the Institute which shall consist of the following members :

- a) The Executive Committee shall function notwithstanding any vacancy therein and notwithstanding any defect in the appointment or nomination of any member and no act or proceedings of the Executive Committee shall be invalidated or nullified merely by reasons of the existence of any vacancy therein or of any defect in the appointment/ nomination of any member.

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- (b) Any casual vacancy amongst the nominated members of the Executive Committee, arising from death or resignation or otherwise, may be filled by nomination by the President and the member so nominated shall hold office for the unexpired portion of the term of office of the member causing the vacancy.
- (c) Every meeting of the Executive Committee shall be presided over by its Chairman and, in his absence, by a member chosen by the Meeting.
- (d) Four members of the Executive Committee present in person shall constitute the quorum. No quorum shall be required for an adjourned meeting.
- (e) For every meeting of the Executive Committee, not less than ten clear days notice shall ordinarily be given to each member. However, the Chairman may, at his discretion, call a meeting with shorter notice if it is considered necessary or expedient due to any reason.
- (f) At least three meetings of the Executive Committee shall be held in each year.
- (g) For the purpose of the last sub-rule, each year shall be deemed to commence, on the first day of April and terminate on the thirty first day of March of the following calendar year.
- (h) The Chairman of the Executive Committee may himself call or by a requisition in writing signed by him may require the Director of the Institute to call a meeting of the Executive Committee at any time.
- (i) Each member of the Executive Committee, including the Chairman, shall have one vote and in case there is an equality of votes on any question to be decided by the Executive Committee, its Chairman or in his absence the person presiding over the meeting shall have a casting vote.
- (j) The Chairman of the Executive Committee may invite any person other than member to attend a meeting of the Executive Committee. Such invitee shall not, however, be entitled to vote at the meeting.
- (k) Any business which may be necessary for the Executive Committee to perform may be carried out by circulation among all its members and any resolution so circulated and approved by a majority of members and signing, shall be as effectual and binding as if the resolution had been passed at a meeting of the Executive Committee.

X. Functions and Powers of the Executive Committee

- (i) Subject to the general control and directions of the Governing Body the Executive Committee shall be responsible for the Management and Administration of the affairs of the Institute in accordance with these rules and bye-laws made thereunder for the furtherance of its objects and shall have all powers which may be necessary or expedient for the purpose and all properties movable and immovable of the Society shall vest in the Executive Committee.
- (ii) **Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing sub-rule, the Executive Committee shall have the following functions, namely :-**
 - (a) to prepare and execute detailed plans and programmes for the furtherance of the objects of the Institute;
 - (b) to create such posts, appoint and control such staff other than those for whose appointment specific provisions have been made elsewhere, as may be required for the efficient management of the affairs of the Institute and to regulate the recruitment and conditions of their service;
 - (c) to receive and to have custody of the funds of the Institute and to manage the properties of the Institute;
 - (d) to enter for and on behalf of the Institute into any agreement including those containing arbitration clauses;
 - (e) to sue and defend all legal proceedings on behalf of the Institute;
 - (f) to appoint Committees including Standing Committee and Academic Committee with powers to coopt, for disposal of any business of the Institute or for advice in any matter pertaining to the Institute, provided that in cases of emergency, the Chairman of the Executive Committee shall have the power to appoint such Committees;
 - (g) to accept the management of any endowment trust, fund, subscription or donation, provided that it is not attended by any condition inconsistent or in conflict with the objects of the Institute;
 - (h) to draw up the annual budget of the Institute to be submitted for approval of the Governing Body;

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- (i) to prepare the annual report and accounts of the Institute for the consideration of the Governing Body;
 - (j) to incur expenditure subject to the provisions of the approved budget;
 - (k) to lay down terms and conditions governing scholarships, fellowships, deputations, grants-in-aid, training and research schemes and projects; and
 - (l) to nominate a person or persons to represent the Institute in national or international conferences and organisations, subjects, in the case of conference or organisations outside India, with the approval of the Government of Haryana in the Development and Panchayats Department.
- (iii) The Executive Committee may, by resolution, delegate to its Chairman, the Standing Committee, the Academic Committee or to the Director of the Institute or to any other officer of the Institute, such of its powers for the conduct of business as it may deem fit, subject, if deemed necessary, to the conditions that action taken by the Chairman, the Standing Committee, the Academic Committee or the Director of the Institute or any other officer, under the powers so delegated shall be subject to confirmation at the next meeting of the Executive Committee.

XI. Standing Committee

The Executive Committee may appoint one or more Standing Committees from amongst its members to attend to and dispose of such business as may be delegated to it by the Executive Committee. The Director of the Institute shall be the Convenor of these Committees and the strength of the Committee shall be such as the Executive Committee may, from time to time, determine. Each Standing Committee shall have the power to coopt as members such person or persons as may be necessary to discharge its functions. The terms of the Standing Committee shall be one year.

XII. Functions of the Standing Committee

All proposal or schemes relating to subject for which Standing Committee has been constituted, whether initiated by the said Committee or otherwise, shall first be considered by the respective Standing Committee and they shall tender advice on such schemes and proposals to the Executive Committee.

XIII. Academic Committee and its Functions

The Executive Committee shall appoint an Academic Committee of which the strength and composition shall be such as the Executive Committee may determine from time to time. The function of the Academic Committee shall be to assist the Executive Committee in matters of academic character such as those pertaining to education, training, research and consultancy. The term of the Academic Committee shall be one year.

XIV. Powers and Functions of the Director-cum-Member Secretary of the Institute

- (i) The Director of the Institute as the Principal Executive Officer of the Institute shall be responsible for the proper administration of the affairs of the Institute and shall exercise powers under the direction and guidance of the Executive Committee.
- (ii) It shall be the duty of the Director of the Institute to co-ordinate and exercise general supervision over all the activities of the Institute.
- (iii) He shall prescribe the duties of all officers and staff of the Institute and shall, subject to these rules and bye-laws if any, exercise such supervision and disciplinary control as may be necessary.

XV. Funds of the Institute

The funds of the Institute shall consist of the following :

- (a) grants made by the Government of Haryana, the Government of India or any other State Government.
- (b) donations and contributions from other sources.
- (c) fees and charges imposed by the Institute for services rendered by it.
- (d) income and receipts from other sources.
- (e) income from investments.

The funds of the Institute will be operated by the Director or any other officer authorised by him.

The bankers of the Institute shall be the Punjab National Bank and any other Nationalised Bank whom the Executive Committee may approve by a resolution.

All funds shall be paid into the Institute's account/accounts with a branch/branches of the Bank as prescribed above and shall not be withdrawn except by means of a cheque, order or any other negotiable instrument signed by the Director of the Institute or an officer authorised by him on his behalf.

XVI. Powers of the Government

In the discharge of its functions, the Governing Body and the Executive Committee shall be guided by such directions on questions of policy as may be given to it by the Government of Haryana. Such directions shall be in writing.

XVII. Audit and Accounts

- (i) The Institute shall cause regular accounts to be kept of all its money and properties in such form as may be prescribed by the Executive Committee.
- (ii) The accounts of the Institute shall be audited annually by Auditors appointed by the Governing Body. The Auditors shall have the right to demand the production of Books, accounts and connected vouchers and other necessary documents and papers. Any expenditure incurred in regard to such audit shall be payable by the Institute.
- (iii) The results of Audit shall be communicated by the Auditors to the Governing Body of the Institute. The Auditors shall also forward a copy of the report direct to the Government of Haryana. The Governing Body shall submit a copy of the Audit Report alongwith its observations to the Government of Haryana.

XVIII. Annual Report

An annual report of the proceedings of the Institute and of all works undertaken during a year together with the balance sheet and audited accounts shall be prepared by the Executive Committee for the information of the Government of Haryana and of the member of Governing Body of the Institute. A draft of such report and yearly accounts of the Institute shall be placed before the Governing Body at the Annual General Meeting.

XIX. Office of the Institute

The office of the Institute shall, for the present, be at Nilokheri or at such other place as may be determined by the Government of Haryana from time to time.

XX. Suits and proceedings by and against the Society

- i) The Society may sue or may be sued in the name of the Chairman or Secretary or any office bearer authorised by the Governing Body in this behalf.
- (ii) No suit or proceeding shall abate by reason of any vacancy or change in the holder of the office of the Chairman, the Secretary or any office bearer authorised in this behalf.

- (iii) Every decree order against the Society in any suit or proceeding shall be executed against the property of the Society and not against the person or the property of the Chairman, the Secretary or any office bearer.
- (iv) Every member of the Society may be sued or prosecuted by the Society for any loss or damage caused to the Society or its property or for any thing done by him detrimental to the interests of the Society. Provided that no action shall be taken against the member for any thing done by him in good faith.

XXI. Alteration or extension of the purpose of the Institute

Subject to the provision of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), the Governing Body may alter, extend or abridge, any purpose or purposes for which the Society is established.

XXII. Amendment of the Rules

The rules of the Society may be altered at any time by a resolution passed by a majority of the total membership of the Governing Body and by a majority of not less than two-thirds of members present and voting at any meeting of the Governing Body which shall have been convened for the specific purpose after giving due notice of such resolution to the members of the Governing Body, provided that until such time as the Governing Body is constituted, the rules may be altered by a resolution passed by the members of the first Executive Committee.

XXIII. If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Society, there remains after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Society, but shall be given or transferred to some other institutions having objects similar to the objects of the Society to be determined by the members of the Society at or before the time of dissolution.
